Here are a few steps to remember when filling out an HVAC Equipment Rebate Application.

Step 1 – Work with the customer to ensure all necessary information, including the customer’s signature, is properly filled out on the rebate application.

Step 2 – Complete all required information on the table titled HVAC Energy Efficiency Systems by selecting the row that corresponds to the measure and SEER rating of the HVAC equipment installed.

Step 3 – A valid AHRI Certificate of Product Ratings* must be submitted with all rebate applications. The manufacturer and model number of the equipment listed on the AHRI Certificate must match the manufacturer and model number listed on the

rebate application and receipt. Manufacturer’s specification sheets are also accepted.

Step 4 – A receipt for the installed HVAC equipment must be submitted with the rebate application and include the following information:

- a) Complete contact information for both contractor and customer
- b) The date the equipment was purchased
- c) A description of the installed equipment, including the manufacturer and model number
- d) The total price of the installed equipment
- e) A receipt marked PAID IN FULL or zero balance due*
- f) The furnace must be listed on the receipt if the AHRI certificate lists a furnace as a component in the efficiency rating. If the furnace was not installed with the air conditioning equipment,

the receipt must list the furnace model number and note that the furnace is pre-existing.

Step 5 – Verify that the model numbers listed on the application, AHRI certificate and receipt match.

Step 6 – Mail the completed rebate application, AHRI certificate and receipt to the address listed on the rebate form.
